Peter Ney 1841-1913 is one of the 38 pioneers who came from Eastern Iowa to NW Iowa by ox train in May of 1870 and settled on the SE quarter of section 24 of Floyd Township in Sioux County, Iowa. Peter was born November 6, 1841 at Tuntange, Luxembourg to Frederick Ney 1802-1872 and Maria Schneider 1815-1894. Peter married Catherine Hilgert 1840-1894 on April 30, 1872 in Cook County, Illinois. Together thay had at least 2 children.

Peter died on July 28, 1913 at Granville, Iowa and is buried with his wife in St Joseph cemetery at Granville, Iowa.

INTRODUCTION

This book is privatized. Privatized means that information (names, dates and places) about living people is not shown, except where they may be mentioned in some public published document (newspaper, vital record, census record, headstone, etc.). They will be shown as "Living" without the quotes. People without a death date who are older than 100 will not be privatized. There are many such people where I have not found a death date to enter. I will maintain a file of such email requests in order to protect myself from possible future lawsuites about any information disclosed in these non-privatized books. And, if you wish, I can create and furnish you with a unique password for your requested digital genealogy book.

I apologize for any misspellings of given names and surnames. Prior to about 1790 the surname given to the children on recorded documents was not always the same as their father's surname. Rather, it was more often the name of the house where they were born. Children were sometimes born in the house of their mother's family. In cases where these types of birth records occur, I often give the child, and his descendants going forward, a hyphenated surname such as Kass-Loes or Hansen-Wag(e)ner for example. Wagner is sometime spelled as Wagener, thus the (e). Also, the spelling of a surname on records is not always the same. On one of my own Luxembourg "Arens" records this surname is spelled three different ways on the very same document.

The spelling of given names, such as "John", for example depended upon the nationality of the family; Jean for French, Johann for German, and Johannes for Latin and John for English and many other variations such at lan, Ivan, Juan, etc. Wherever possible in my genealogy books I use the "Americanized" version of given names. For example, Nicholas instead of Nikolas etc.

Much of the Luxembourg genealogy in this book has been taken from the marvelous work of the people who created and maintain the Luxembourg genealogy web site called https://luxembourg.com.






Map of Luxembourg and German birth locations of the foreign born 1870 NW lowa pioneers

1884 Sioux County plat map with 1870 pioneer farms marked




1884 Plymouth Co. map with Nicholas Kass 1880 location


Pedigree Chart for Peter (John Peter) Ney


Pedigree Chart for Domonic (Neu) Ney
